BYLAW NO.3

At a general session held in Portage du Fort, on the 11 day of December, 1856, at the hour of nine of the clock A.M., at which meeting are present P.F. Fox, mayor of Litchfield, acting as warden (W.L. Gray, warden, being absent), and the following county councillors:

- John Dale mayor of Clarendon
- John Beahan mayor of Onslow
- George Bryson mayor of Mansfield
- Robert Shirley mayor of Bristol

The secretary-treasurer being also present.

Moved by George Bryson, seconded by Robert Shirley and resolved that the following bylaw be adopted:

As it appears by the assessment rolls of the county amounts to £200.619 that one half penny on the £ be levied on the amount of assessment in this county with the intention of opening up the county road to Fort William.

Carried unanimously.
