BYLAW NO.18

At an adjourned quarterly session held in Havelock village, on Wednesday the 13th day of March, 1867, at which meeting are present His Worship Warden William O'Meara, mayor of Portage du Fort, and the following county councillors:

- John B. Poupore mayor of Chichester
- Simon McNally mayor of Calumet Island

forming a quorum of council. The secretary-treasurer being also present.

The said council doth hereby ordain and make the following bylaw:

"A bylaw for levying the county rate for the year 1867"

It is expedient and it is hereby enacted that the sum of one hundred and fourteen dollars and fifty-eight cents (\$114.58) be levied for the purposes of defraying the expenses of this council for the current year of 1867, that the said amount of one hundred and fourteen dollars and fifty eight cents (\$114.58) be raised by a rate of one hundredth of a cent on each dollar in the valuation roll of each local municipality in this county and that in accordance with said rate each of the said municipalities do pay as their respective quota of said rate, the amount now below mentioned, that is to say:

- Bristol 16.50
- Clarendon 20.50
- Portage du Fort 8.63
- Thorne 5.43
- Leslie 2.09
- Litchfield 10.73
- Mansfield 3.40
- Waltham 1.10
- Chichester 3.60
