BYLAW NO.20

At a general half yearly session held in Havelock, Quebec, on Wednesday the 10th of June, 1868, at the hour of ten o'clock in the forenoon, at which meeting are present His Worship Warden William O'Meara, mayor of Portage du Fort, and the following county councillors:

- Thomas McVeagh mayor of Litchfield
- James McCool mayor of Chichester

forming a quorum of council. The secretary-treasurer being also present.

The said council doth hereby ordain and make the following bylaw:

"A bylaw to levy the county rate for the current year (1868)."

It is expedient and it is hereby enacted that the sum of fifty-eight dollars (\$58.00) be levied on this county for the purpose of defraying the expenses of this council for the year ending 31st of December now next ensuing and that each of the local municipalities in the county do pay a rate of one two hundredth part of a cent on the dollar in the amount of each of their valuation rolls.
