BYLAW NO.21

At a general half yearly session held in Havelock, Quebec, on Thursday the 9th of December, 1869, at which meeting are present His Worship Warden William O'Meara, mayor of Portage du Fort, and the following county councillors:

forming a quorum of council. The secretary-treasurer being also present.

The said council doth hereby ordain and make the following bylaw:

"A bylaw to levy the county rate for the year 1867."

It is expedient and it is hereby enacted that the sum of one hundred and fifty-seven dollars (\$157.00) be levied on this county for the purpose of defraying the expenses of this council for the year ending the 31st of December now next ensuing and that each of the local municipalities composing the county do pay a rate of one eightieth of a cent on the dollar on the amount of their respective valuation rolls.
