BYLAW NO.23

At a general quarterly session held in Havelock on Wednesday the 14th day of December 1870, at which meeting are present His Worship Warden William O'Meara, mayor of Portage du Fort, and the following county councillors:

- Thomas McVeagh mayor of Litchfield
- James McCool mayor of Chichester
- James Martin mayor of Thorne
- John F. Coghlan mayor of Waltham
- Michael Craig mayor of Sheen
- Alexander Proudfoot mayor of Mansfield
- Simon McNally mayor of Calumet Island
- William Logue mayor of Onslow
- Walter Russell mayor of Bristol
- William McDowell mayor of Clarendon

forming a quorum of council. The secretary-treasurer being also present.

The said council do hereby ordain and make the following bylaw:

"A bylaw to levy and impose the county rate for the current year, 1870."

It is hereby enacted that a tax be levied on the general municipalities of this county of one eightieth of a cent of a dollar, on the value of property mentioned and assessed in their general assessment rolls, for county purposes for the current year, 1870, ensuing by said tax the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars (\$150.00).
