BYLAW NO.25

At a general quarterly session held at Havelock on Wednesday the thirteenth day of September, 1871, at which session are present His Worship Warden, William O'Meara, mayor of Portage du Fort and the following councillors:

- Walter Russell mayor of Bristol
- William Logue mayor of Onslow
- Simon McNally mayor of Calumet Island
- John Coghlan mayor of Waltham
- Alexander Proudfoot mayor of Mansfield
- Terence Duff mayor of Allumette Island
- James McCool mayor of Chichester
- William McDowell mayor of Clarendon
- James Martin mayor of Thorne

forming a quorum of council. The secretary-treasurer also being present.

The said council doth make and ordain the following bylaw:

"A bylaw to levy and impose the county rate for the current year."

It is expedient and be it hereby enacted that a tax be levied on each municipality of this county of one eightieth of a cent on the dollar on every dollar of property mentioned and described and assessed in the several assessment rolls for county purposes for the current year (1871) raising by said rate the sum of on each municipality as follows:

- Onslow the sum of nineteen $\frac{32}{100}$ dollars
- Bristol the sum of seventeen $\frac{75}{100}$ dollars
- Clarendon the sum of thirty $\frac{10}{100}$ dollars
- Litchfield the sum of eighteen dollars
- Portage du Fort the sum of eleven $\frac{94}{100}$ dollars
- Calumet Island the sum of ten $\frac{38}{100}$ dollars
- Mansfield & Pontefract the sum of six $\frac{65}{100}$ dollars
- Allumette Island the sum of fifteen $\frac{70}{100}$ dollars
- Waltham & Bryson the sum of four $\frac{24}{100}$ dollars
- Sheen the sum of five $\frac{66}{100}$ dollars
- Chichester the sum of six dollars
- Thorne the sum of eight $\frac{10}{100}$ dollars
- Leslie the sum of three $\frac{10}{100}$ dollars

Amounting in all to the sum of one hundred and fifty seven dollars.
