

Pontiac Heritage Awards

These Heritage Awards, an initiative of the Pontiac MRC, the Ministry of Culture, Communications and Status of Women and the Pontiac CLD, have been created to reward owners who have worked on the development of historic houses in Pontiac.

Terms:

Your application must contain the following:

- The application form duly completed;
- Color photographs of the house before and after work ;
- If possible, photographs of the old house or any other archive documents on the history of the house and showing in its original state;

Eligibility:

- Only heritage homes will be eligible. The cultural agents will assess the cultural heritage character of the house;
- Only outside renovations will be considered;
- Private homeowners and non-profit organizations can participate.

The awards recognize owners who have renovated a heritage home or who have given it an original aspect (old photographs are mandatory in these projects). Modern materials may also be accepted if they do not diminish the architectural quality and heritage value of the building.

Evaluation of the file :

Evaluation criteria will be considered as:

- Respect for the architectural authenticity;
- Quality of work performed under the original appearance;
- Quality materials used;
- Integration of work to the house;

- Improved asset value;
- Quality and harmonious aesthetics (walls colors, enhancement of landscape site);
- Total costs of work performed.

Inscription :

You are invited to contact the Pontiac CLD cultural agents to create your file and see whether your house is eligible for Heritage Awards.

Your application must be filed before October 31, 2010.

Awards:

Prizes will be awarded in November 2010. Three prizes will be awarded to owners whose projects will best meet the evaluation criteria.

Each Prize will be awarded with a honorary plaque. A total of 3 000 \$ (\$ 2 250 from the Pontiac MRC and \$750 from the MCCCCF) will be distributed among the three winners. Each amount will be determined by the jury according to the quality and total cost of the renovations.
